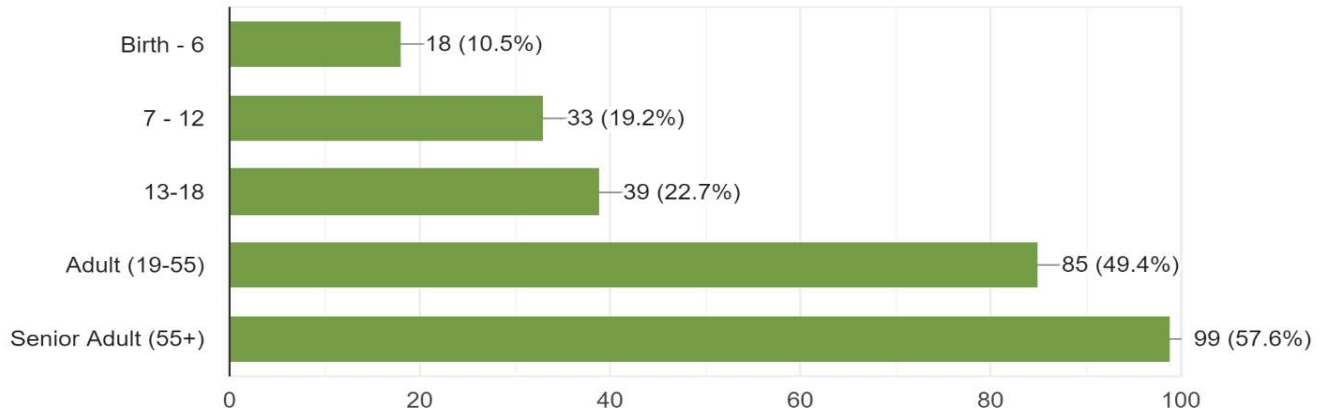

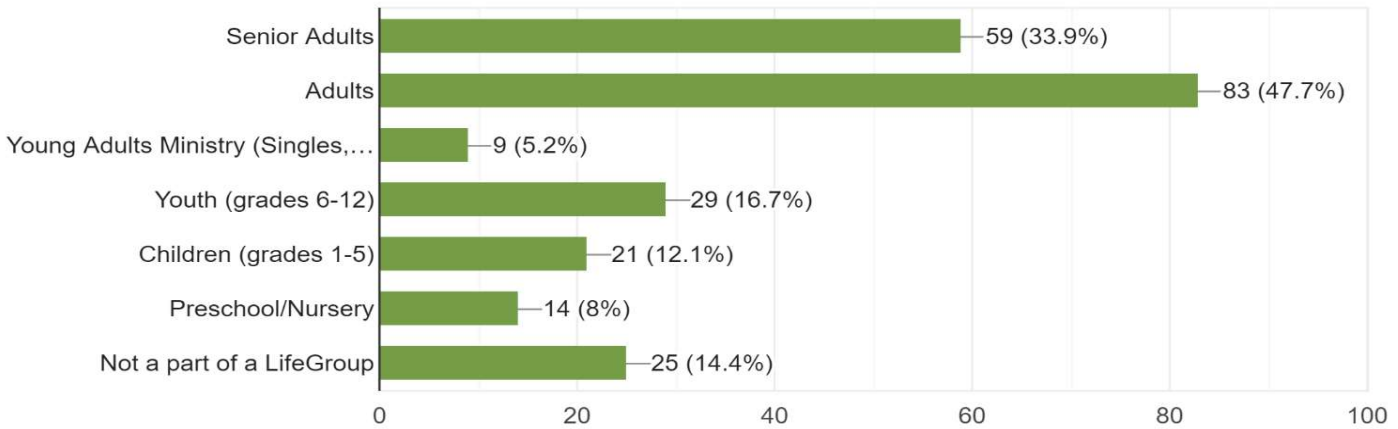

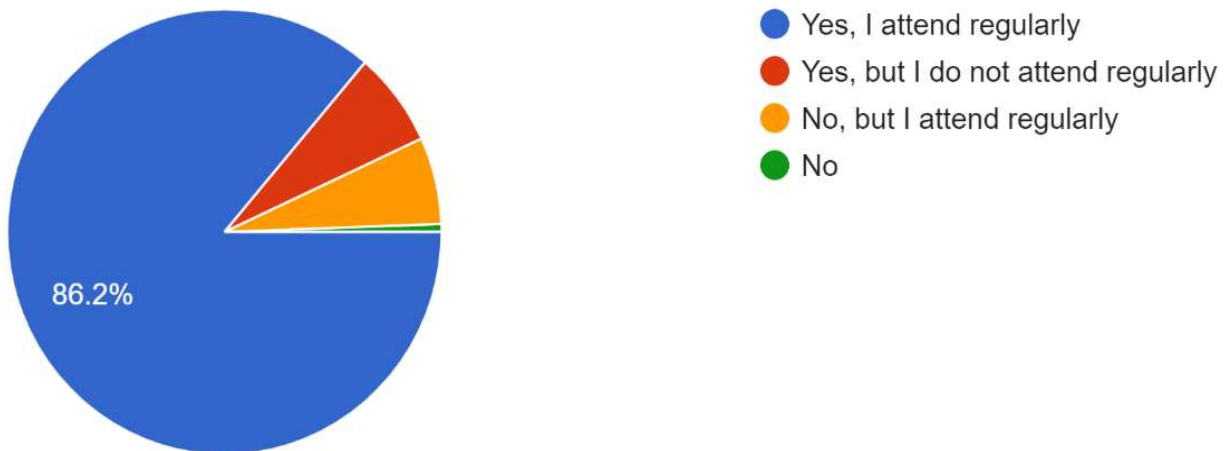
What age ranges are represented in your household?



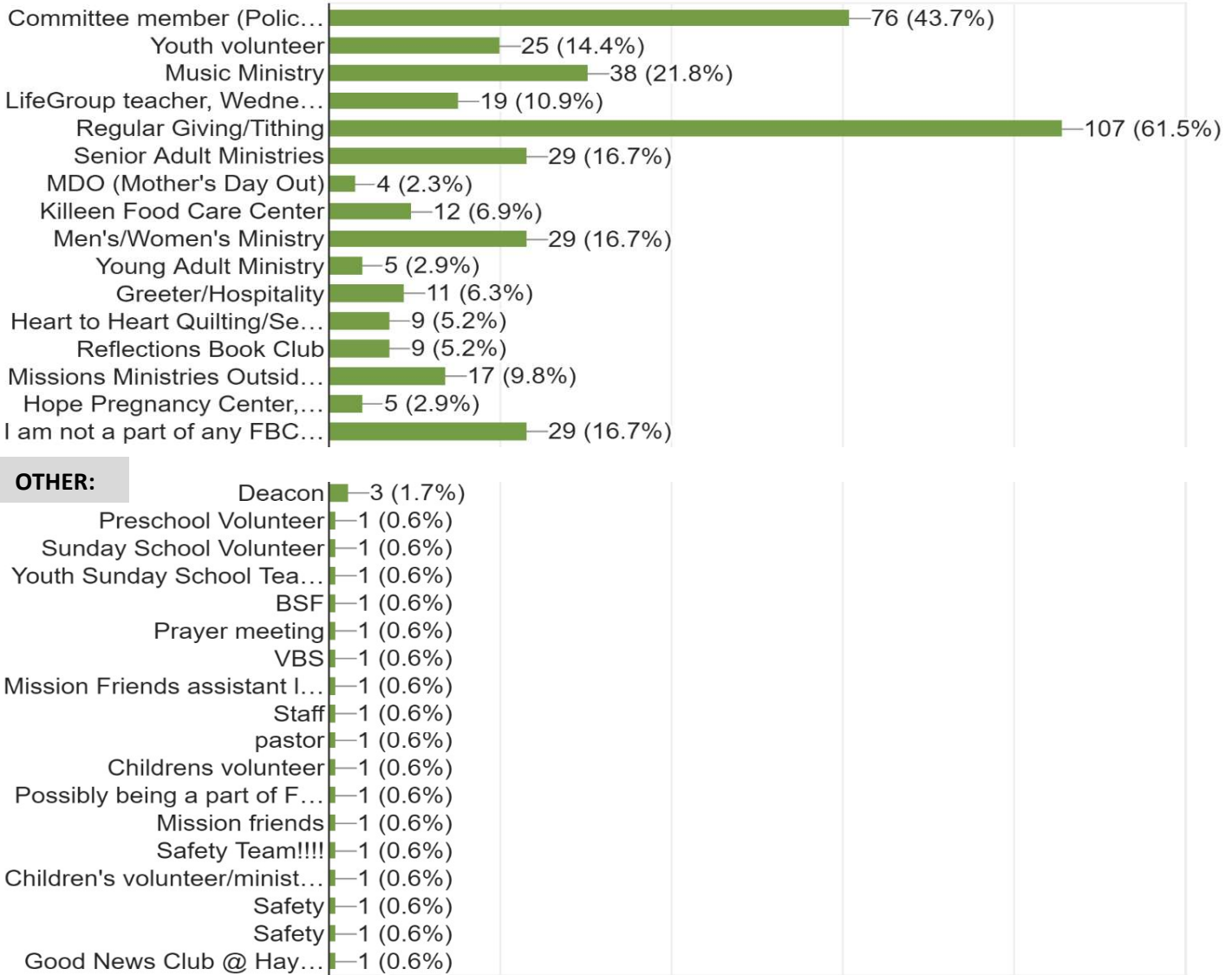
Which LifeGroups are you and your family a regular part of? (Please select all that apply.)



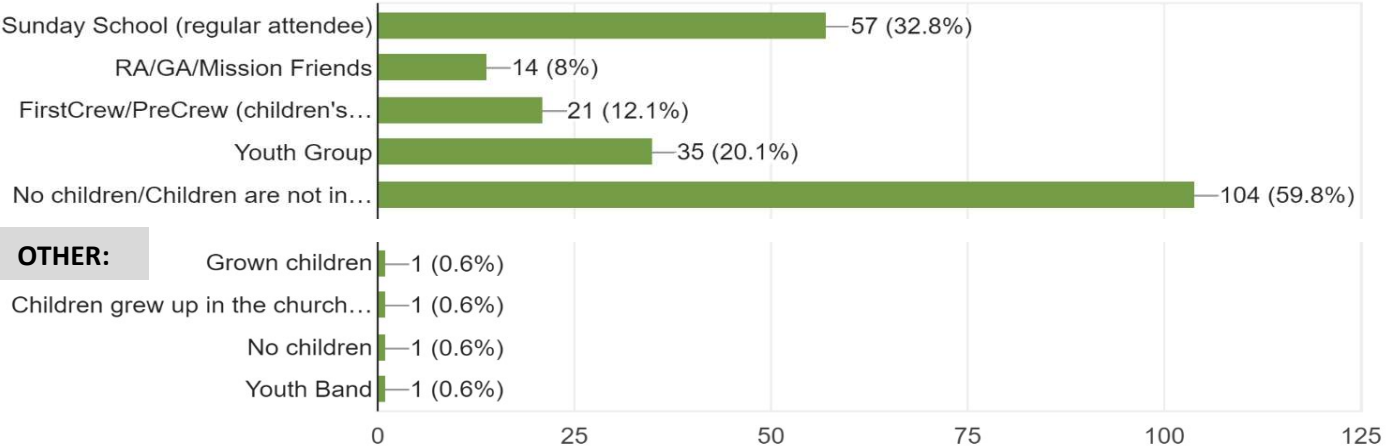
Are you a member of FBC Killeen?



Which FBC Killeen ministries are you a part of? (Please select all that apply.)

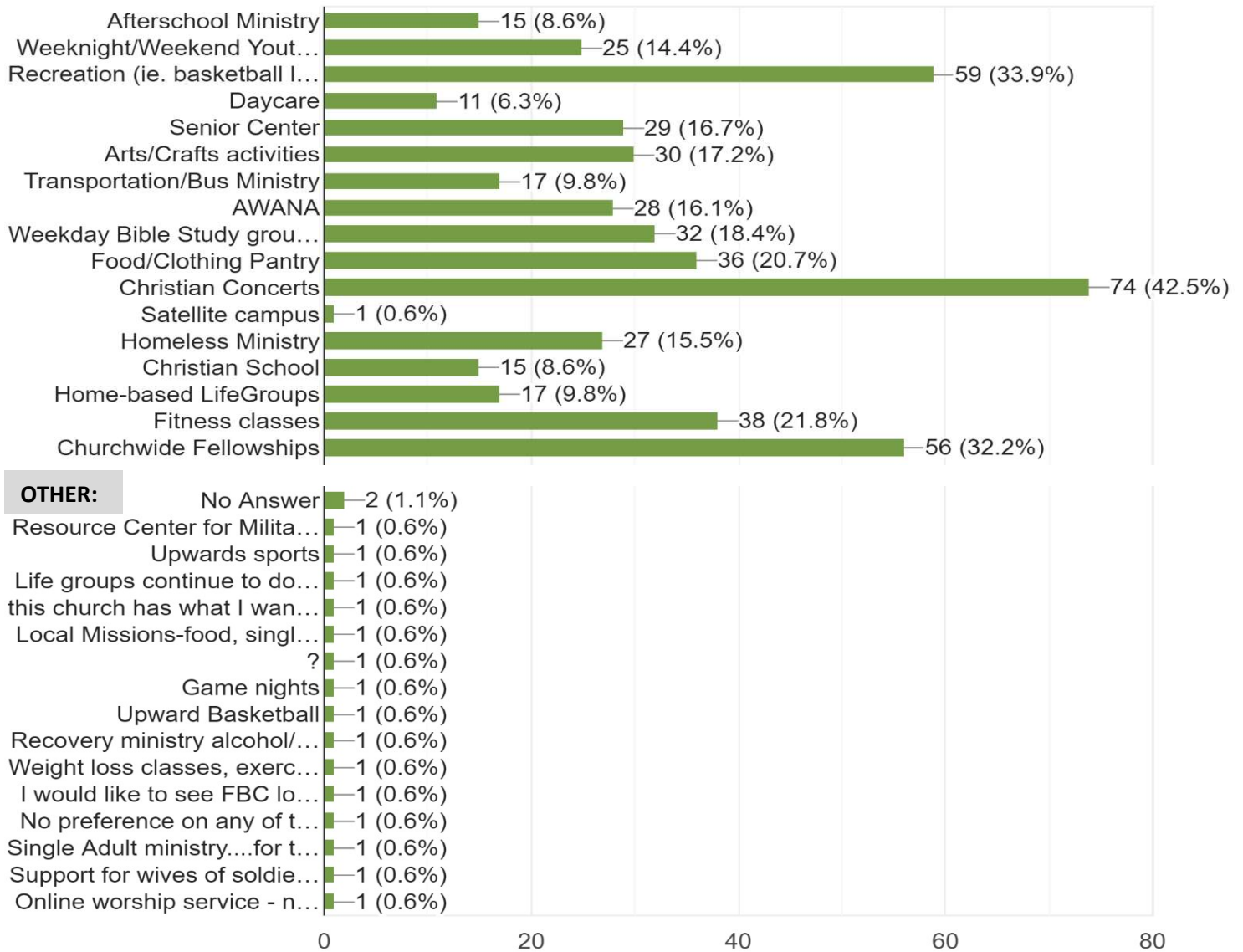


Which ministries are your children involved in? (Please select all that apply.)

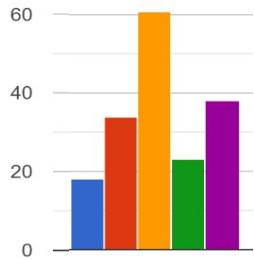
How important are each of these facility needs for FBC?

Facility Needs Ranking



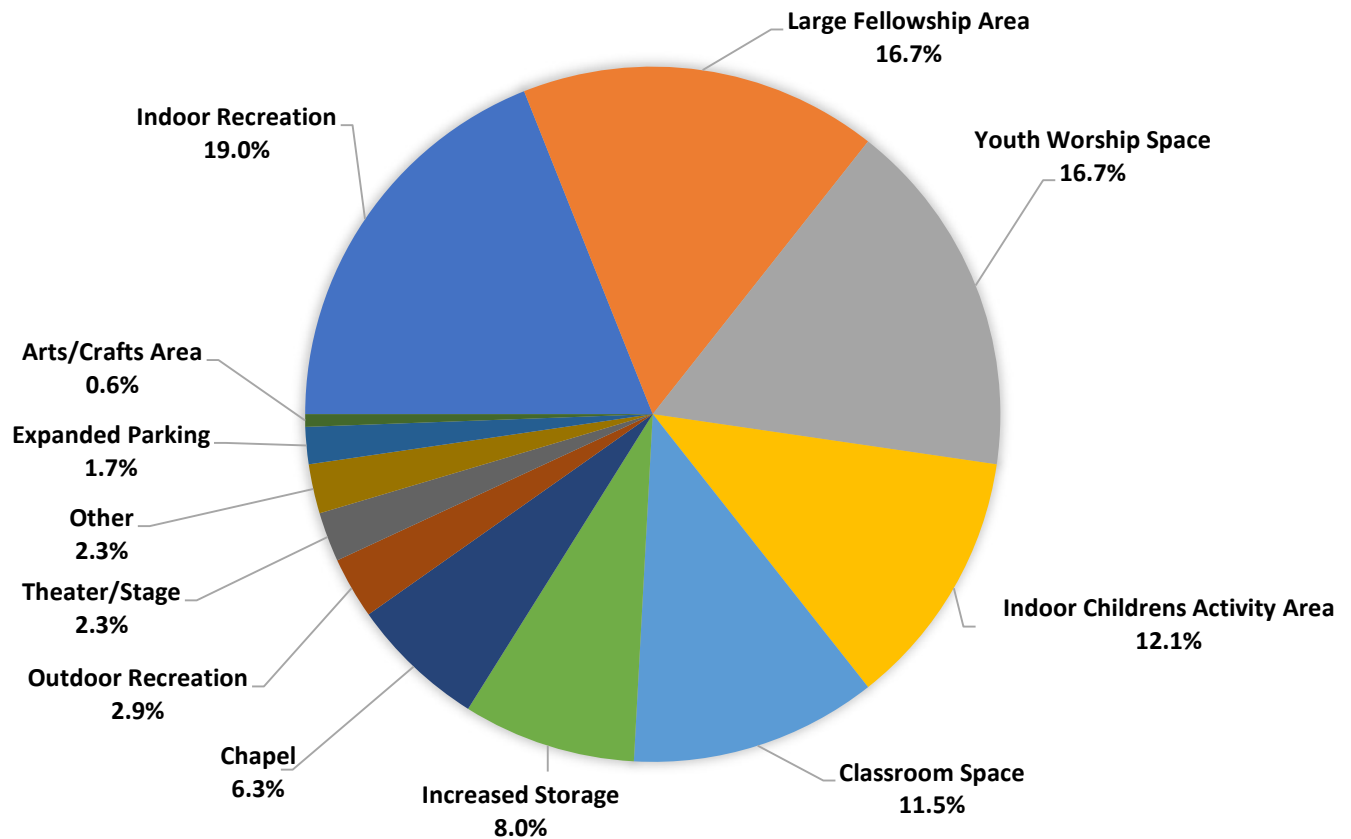

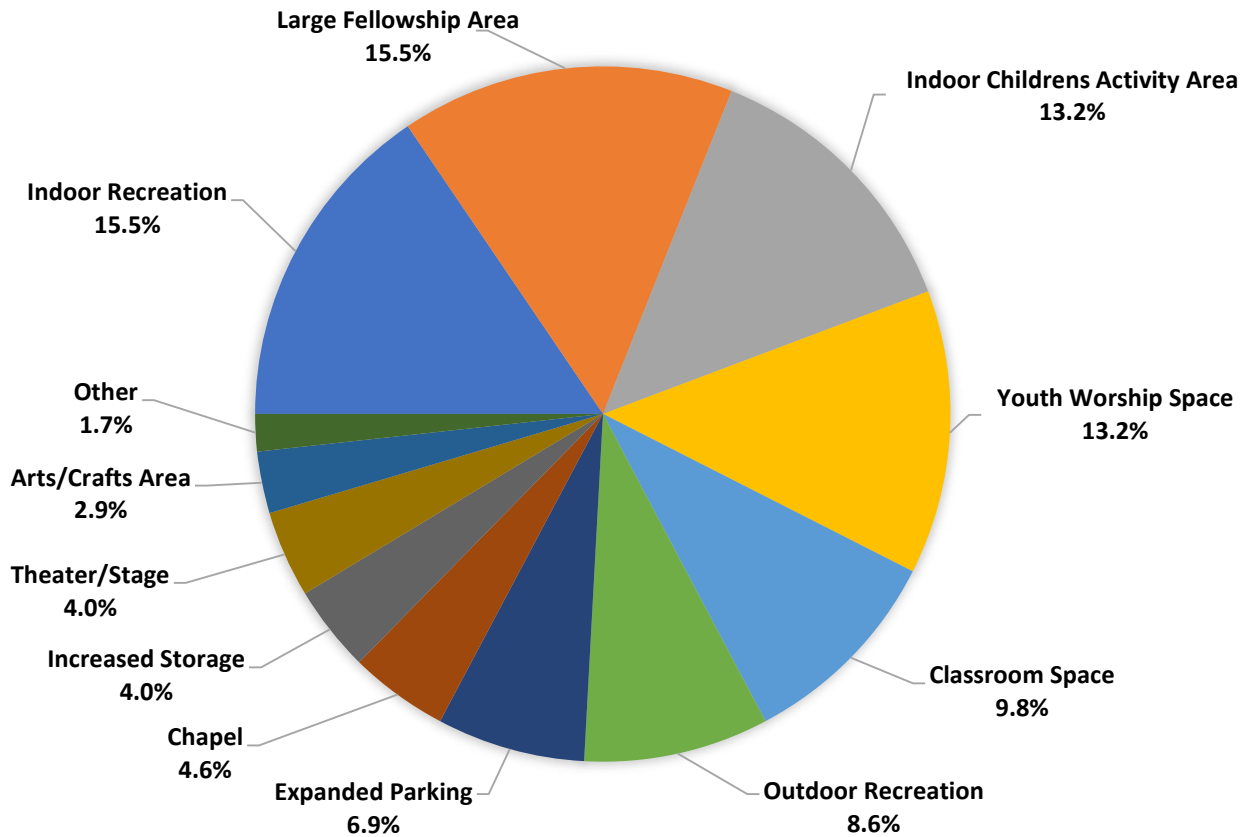

Do you have any additional thoughts that may help guide your Building Committee?

- A building large enough to host many diverse activities so that the main building can remain closed. A kitchen.
- All committees should be involved in the decisions made concerning the construction, especially Safety. The protection of the congregation should be the top priority and built into the plan as opposed to adding protective measures later. Reflect back on lessons learned during the construction of the church; ...we shoulda done this and shoulda done that... and not make the same oversites. The postulated threat towards churches has changed since ours was first built. Keep that in mind...Prayer
- Any biblical imagery or symbolism or scriptures that are included in the exterior or interior of the building may serve as good reminders of God's Word and His teachings.
- Blowout youth area. It's too small and space not used, chapel that can be used for chior practice, convert choir area to children's indoor play area, put divider walls in some of the existing rooms to allow for large room options, ensure you put a quality kitchen in family life center, not a small one like fellowship hall.
- Build now what we need / want. A building is not "building" but rather a "built". Once it is completed, it is too late to go back and rebuild.
- Build something as soon as possible
- Chapel: weddings, funerals, save utilities on heat/air/lights for small programs; large SS groups (adults) meet
- Increase worship area as designed (on sides) or attendance increase. Then needd SS space is used.
- Christian school K-12
- Classic, durable and energy efficient design.
- Don't just settle! Make it count! We have a challenge to build something and provide something great in this challenging time. If we build it they would come! If we spark interest, it will draw people. If we draw people, we can save lives!
- Enlarged Fellowship hall needs adequate kitchen space to accommodate needs of groups meeting in the Fellowship Hall.
- Family center needs to be fast tracked; should have been done years ago when Jerry Ward suggested a plan for a building
- FBC needs to value the Gen Z and Millennial generations, they are the future church, and move to meet their needs. The ministry models of 30 years ago are not meeting these generational needs. In this digital era connection with the folks outside of the church is through digital media...it is the church's new "front door." Meeting in small groups outside the church. Small group worship opportunities where more one on one fellowship can transpire.
- Focus on location of the new building from a safety standpoint. Build close enough to the main building so that travel to and from could occur under a breezeway and simultaneous activities in either location could be safely monitored by church staff.
- Go look at Skyline Bapt & Grace Christian Center

- Have the new building somehow connected to the existing building. For example: Covered and paved walkway.
- I pray that we think about the future of the church and the possible ministries we would be able to do with a family life center. I believe this is a great way to reach more people in our city and help people get to know Christ and grow in their relationship with Christ
- I think you will have to hire a full-time person to be "in charge" of all of the activities that go on in the facility. Someone who will keep all of the kitchen appliances, etc clean & in good working order. A volunteer will not work in this situation. I'm wondering if a physician/medical personnel would have to be at all games. Just a few thoughts. I have talked to others who have belonged to a church with a Family Life Center and these are some of their responses to my questions.

- I would love to see a versatile, outside covered area to be used as an extension with our large fellowships or events. Currently, we can only use the small carport at the backside of the building and it's much too small to be fully functional. This would also be a nice area to have benches or picnic tables so that people could clear out of the church building after services and then spend leisurely time together, continuing to mingle, in the shade and comfort of the outdoor space.
- I would suggest visiting churches in our area that have this type of area and see how they do it, what they like and don't and wish they had/didn't do. I know FBC Belton, Memorial Baptist and Skyline all have areas similar to what we may want.
- I'm not certain timing is appropriate for tackling a major building project with current budget deficits and our limited church attendance. Prayers that the committee and our church leadership will have discernment and be good stewards of our resources during this challenging time. 🙏
